Notes:

- Only Indian nationals need to apply. Applications from Indian nationals abroad will also be considered. If short listed, interviews may be held for Indian nationals abroad via video conferencing on the same day as in the other cases for the specified post.
- 2. Selection will be made on the basis of a) brief presentation on area of interest; and b) personal interview
- 3. The decision of the selection committee will be final.
- 4. Any form of canvassing will be a disqualification.
- 5. The Institute reserves the right to keep the post vacant if no suitable candidate is found.
- 6. The Institute reserves the right to shortlist a smaller number of applicants from those who fulfill the minimum advertised conditions.
- 7. Preference will be given to those who have demonstrated research capabilities and can handle large projects.

- 8. The selected candidates should be able to work in a multicultural research environment.
- 9. The selected candidates are expected to join duty by the first week of March 2025.
- 10. The appointment of the above posts will initially be having two years of probation with review each year. Depending on the evaluation at the end of two years period, the appointment shall either be made permanent or extended or terminated.
- 11. The above pay scale is likely to be revised as per 7th CPC once the institute gets approval. Partial Implementation of 7th CPC is underway.
